

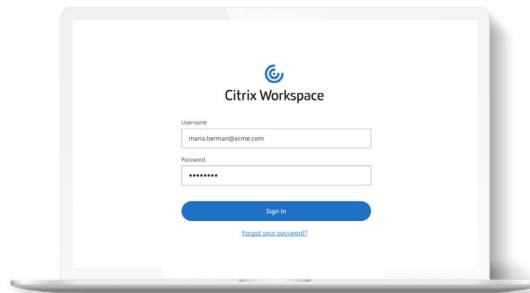

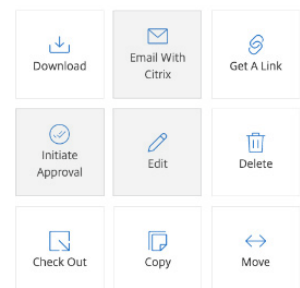
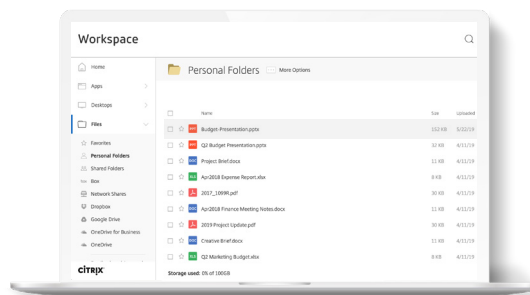
1. Find what you need in seconds

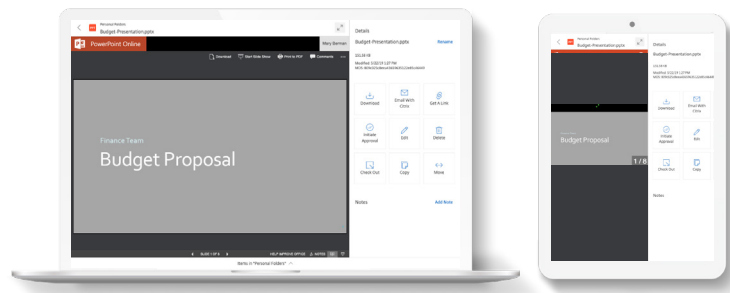

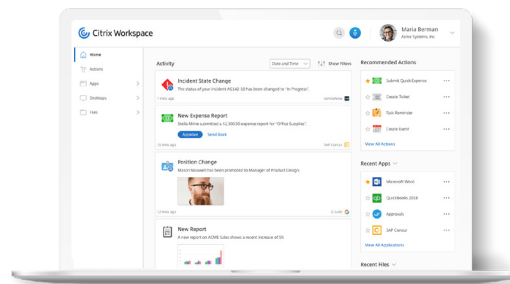
