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Background

Exam: Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops 7 Advanced Administration

The exam for this certification is the Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops 7 Advanced Administration exam. It is designed for IT professionals who manage and support complex, on-premises or cloud-based Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops environments and are looking to expand their skills to an advanced level.

Prerequisite

To be eligible to take this exam, you must first pass the Citrix Certified Associate - Virtualization (CCA-V) exam.

Intended Audience and Prerequisite Knowledge

The exam is designed for administrators, consultants, and engineers who manage and support a complex Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops environment.

Before taking this exam, candidates should have:

- Knowledge of Windows Server 2016 roles and features, Active Directory, DNS, DHCP, GPOs, and NTFS permissions.
- Familiarity with SQL Server clustering and mirroring.
- Experience with Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops 7, Citrix App Layering, and StoreFront.

Exam Structure and Format

- Number of items: The exam consists of 60 to 65 questions.
- Format: The exam is delivered and scored by a computer, with a variety of question types including multiple-choice.
- Time Limit: Candidates have 90 minutes to complete the exam.
- Passing Score: The passing score for this exam is 65%.
- Language: The exam is available in English.
- Resources: No external reference materials are allowed during the exam.

- Module 4: Advanced Workspace Environment Management (WEM): Explores advanced features of WEM for performance optimization and profile management.
- Module 5: Advanced Security: Covers security considerations including TLS, app protection policies, and session recording.
- Module 6: Advanced Troubleshooting: Discusses troubleshooting methodology, tools, and techniques for a complex environment.
- Module 7: Advanced Cloud Concepts: Covers key cloud concepts and how to manage a hybrid environment with Citrix Cloud.
